are Thine*

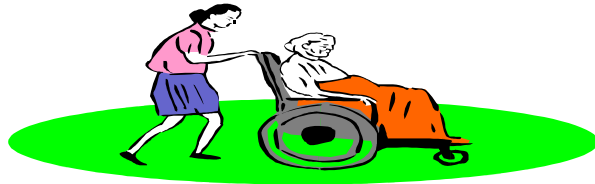
